



Deborah Jordy Leadership Arts Scholarship

The Deborah Jordy Leadership Arts Scholarship is in honor of CBCA's former executive director, Deborah Jordy, who served the organization for over 12 years. It was created by the CBCA Board of Directors in late 2016 and will be inaugurated for the 2017-2018 Leadership Arts class.

Leadership Arts is committed to ensuring that cultural nonprofits are led by diverse, effective and inspired Board members. We also strive to build an inclusive community of arts advocates. This scholarship is intended to recognize true leadership potential and a diversity of perspectives in advancing arts and culture.

The Deborah Jordy Leadership Arts Scholarship will provide full tuition coverage to one outstanding applicant. For 2017-2018, the value of non-member tuition is \$2,200.

Criteria

- Resident of Colorado
- Demonstrate passion for arts and culture
- Demonstrate interest in civic engagement and volunteer leadership
- Ability to attend and participate fully in all 9 Leadership Arts sessions for the 2017-2018 program (monthly half-day classes from September through May)

How to Apply

The following items must be submitted to CBCA by Friday, August 11.

- Leadership Arts Application (submitted online)
 - o Application form
 - o Resume
 - o Headshot
 - o \$100 Deposit (refundable for scholarship recipient)
- Scholarship Letter that describes:
 - o Why you are applying for this scholarship
 - o Your personal and professional goals related to volunteer leadership and civic engagement in the arts.
 - o How your participation in Leadership Arts will positively impact your personal and professional goals.
 - o How your participation in Leadership Arts will positively impact the class, as well as our cultural community at large.
- Letter of Recommendation from employer, colleague or community member
